## **Course T105/4**

Start at mark on kerbstone level with the third broken line on the junction of the old lane (closed the motor vehicles), and proceed out onto the road exiting Sedgfield to the south east. After 245 yards bear left onto the slip road to join the A689 towards Hartlepool. At the roundabout for Wynyard Village continue ahead on the A689 (4.07 miles) to the Wynyard Business Park Roundabout (5.08 miles) (M). Encircle the roundabout and retrace on the A689 to the Wynyard Village roundabout (6.18 miles). Continue ahead on the A689 and finish at the second of five lampposts, and mark on the kerb, immediately before the junction with the road into Sedgfield on which you started (10 miles). **After finishing riders must proceed to and turn round the roundabout with the A177 to return to the Parish Hall via Stockton Road. There is no right turn for all vehicles from the Finish into Stockton Road.**

## **Numbers and Results etc.**

Numbers, results, refreshments and toilet facilities are at Sedgfield Parish Hall, off the High Street, Sedgfield.

## **Parking**

There should be ample parking for competitors at the Parish Hall. Any overflow can be accommodated on the old A177 directly over the A689 from the start. Please be aware of traffic on the A689 if using this area to park and prepare.

## **National Championship Prizes**

A gold medal, badge and certificate to the first individual; a silver medal and certificate to the second individual; a bronze medal and certificate to the third individual. Gold medals and certificates to the first school team.

## **Regional Championship Prizes**

A gold medal, badge and certificate to the first individual; certificates to the second and third individuals. Certificates to the first school team

## **C.T.T. District guidelines**

- o No turbo trainers within 100 metres of inhabited properties
- o No U turns within sight of the start
- o No warming up on the course once the event has started
- o No cars (other than those of Officials) at the start or finish

**CTT Reg.15: All competitors under 18 MUST wear a properly affixed helmet which must be of hard/soft shell construction. Helmets should conform to a recognised standard... It is the responsibility of the rider's parent or guardian to: a) select a helmet which offers protection...and does not restrict the rider's vision or hearing, b) ensure the helmet is properly fitted, is undamaged and in good condition.**

**Children competing in National and Regional events must compete by their own efforts**

**A notice will be on display at the HQ identifying significant risks, which may affect riders' safety.**
